

HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON
BY-LAW # 153/00

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE HAMLET OF FORT
MCPHERSON IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL CLEAN-UP
OF PUBLIC AREAS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE HAMLETS ACT, R.S.N.W.T.,
1988, c. H-1, s. 85.


As it is desirable to provide a clean and healthy living environment for all residents *and visitors* with health, safety and aesthetic values being important considerations;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, in a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as the "Annual Clean up By-law".
2. In this By-law:
 - a. "Council" means the elected officials of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson;
 - b. "Garbage" means any form of refuse as defined in the Garbage Collection By-law;
 - c. "Hamlet" means the Hamlet of Fort McPherson and its boundary;
 - d. "SAO" means the Senior Administrative Officer employed by the Hamlet of Fort McPherson;
3. The Council shall, by resolution, declare a period each calendar year, where residents, businesses and organizations will be encouraged to participate in a community clean-up program.
4. The Council **may** appoint an Annual Clean-up Co-ordinator who, under the direction of the Council and/or SAO shall be responsible for organising and co-ordinating the annual clean up. **The Co-ordinator may be paid a per diem for their services.**
5. The Hamlet of Fort McPherson shall provide **3 garbage bags per household** and dispose of the materials collected during the annual community clean up.
6. If during the clean up a fire is desirable to encourage new growth and revitalisation of an area. The Fort McPherson Volunteer Fire Department will be responsible for the ignition, control and extinguishment of all fires.
7. The Hamlet of Fort McPherson may take any action it deems necessary to ensure the safety of the residents during the clean up period.




