TERRITORIES TO GUIDE THE REDEVELOPMENT OF LAND WITHIN THE  
MUNICIPALITY.

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.N.W.T., 1974,  
C.P-8, S-5.

WHEREAS the Council of the Hamlet Of Fort McPherson has prepared  
a General Plan, referred to as " The Hamlet Of Fort McPherson  
Community Plan " Bylaw number 46, in accordance with the Planning  
Act development of land in the Hamlet may be best organized and  
carried out.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council for the Hamlet Of  
Fort McPherson in session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE:

1. This By-law may be cited as the " Community Plan By-Law ".
2. The following are declared to form part of this by-law:
  - a) Schedule I - Policy Statements of Council.
  - b) Schedule II - Land Use Map.
  - c) Schedule III - The Hamlet Of Fort McPherson  
Beautification and Improvement Scheme.
3. This By-Law comes into effect on the day in which it is  
signed by the Hamlet Of Fort McPherson.
