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 BEING A BYLAW OF THE HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON IN THE  
 NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF COUNCIL  
 INDEMNITIES AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES PURSUANT TO THE HAMLETS  
 ACT, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c.H-1, s.34  
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Where as it is necessary to provide for the payment of elected officials by way of an indemnity and to provide for allowances;

Now therefore, the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, in a meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Short Title

This by-law may be cited as Council Indemnity By-law.

2. Interpretation

In this By-law:

- a. "Council" means the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson;
- b. "Councillor" means a member of Council, other than the Mayor;
- c. "Hamlet" means the Hamlet of Fort McPherson;
- d. "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson;
- e. "Meeting" Means a Regular, Special, Emergency or a Committee of the Whole meeting or any other meeting approved by council and minutes are recorded and adopted by Council. *\*Note "Specifically excluded from this definition is attendance by members of Council at meetings where Honorariums are paid by other sources."*

3. Indemnity and Expense Allowance

An indemnity and expense allowance shall be paid to each member of Council in accordance with Appendix "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

4. Travel on behalf of Council

Travel on behalf of the Council must be approved by resolution, at least two weeks before the scheduled meeting date, if and when possible. If the delegate misses any day of the meeting with out a justified reason, he/ she shall reimburse the Hamlet for the total expenses incurred by the Hamlet.

5. Civic Duty


Councillors attending local or outside meetings on their own behalf will not receive any honorarium, unless approved by a Resolution of Council.


6. Repeal

Bylaw # 175/01 is hereby repealed





Appendix "A"

1. An indemnity and expense allowance is payable to the Mayor at the following rates;
  - a. Mayor \$15,600.00 per annum.
  - b. The Mayor's annual indemnity and expense allowance shall be paid in twenty-four (24) equal instalments on the 15<sup>th</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of each month.
2. Councillors shall be paid an indemnity at the following rates;
  - a. Regular Council Meetings \$150.00
  - b. Special Council Meetings \$100.00
  - c. Council Committee Meetings \$50.00
3. The Deputy Mayor or Councillor shall receive an additional \$25.00, when the Deputy Mayor or Councillor chairs a Regular Council Meeting or a Special Council Meeting in the absence of the Mayor.
4. Council indemnities shall be paid on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of each and every month.
  - a. The maximum indemnity payable per year is as follows;
    1. Mayor \$ 15,600.00
    2. Deputy Mayor \$ 5,700.00
    3. Councillors \$ 5,400.00
5. When a Councillor travels on behalf of the Hamlet, he/she shall receive an indemnity of \$150.00 per day, plus a per diem equal to the G.N.W.T. Travel Expense Policy, as amended from time to time.
