



BEING A BY-LAW OF THE HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON IN THE
NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO PROVIDE FOR A CURFEW, PURSUANT TO
THE PROVISIONS OF THE CURFEW ACT, R.S.N.W.T. , 1988, c.C-26 AND THE
HAMLETS ACT, R.S.N.W.T. , 1988, c.H-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This By-law may be cited as the "Curfew By-law".

INTERPRETATIONS

1. (1) In this by-law:
 - a. "Hamlet" means the Hamlet of Fort McPherson in the Northwest Territories.
 - b. "By-law Officer" means a person appointed by a By-law of the Hamlet as a By-law Officer.
 - c. "Child" means a boy or girl under the age of sixteen (16) years.
 - d. "Night-time" means the period of curfew so designated in Schedule 1, attached to and forming part of this By-law.
- (2) Upon application by any person or upon its own initiative, the council may, by resolution, declare that night-time shall not be effective upon a certain day, notwithstanding that school attendance is required on the following day.

RULES

2. No child shall, without reasonable excuse, be on any street or road or in a public place during Night-time unless accompanied by his/her father, mother, legal guardian, or a brother or sister eighteen years of age or more, having been entitled to have lawful custody, care or control of the child.
3. Any Child out after Curfew will be issued a ticket through either parent or legal guardian.
4. All tickets issued will be reported to the local Social Services office.
5. Any person who interferes with the enforcement of this bylaw will be subject to a fine as stated in Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw and the matter will be reported to the RCMP to determine if criminal charges are applicable.

CURFEW TIME


6. The time for curfew shall be as follows;
 - a) From 10:00 pm until 6:00 am the following morning for Sunday through Thursday through out the school year.
 - b) From 12:00 am until 6:00 am when school attendance is not required the following day.
 - c) Any other time council sets by a resolution of council at a regular or special meeting.

REPEAL


7. By-law #105/95 is hereby repealed.





3. Third Offence	\$40.00
4. Each Subsequent Offence	\$50.00
