BY-LAW #81

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON IN THE NORTHWEST
TERRITORIES TO CANCEL THE PAYMENTS OF CERTAIN DEBTS OWING TO THE
MUNICIPALITY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE HAMLETS ACT,
R.S.N.W.T., 1988. C. H-1. s164

WHEREAS the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson has determined
that certain debts owing to the Municipality are uncollectible;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON duly
assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to the approval of the Minister, all those debts owed
to the Hamlet of Fort McPherson listed in Schedule 1, are not
being debts in respect of property taxes, are hereby wholly
forgiven; for the reasons determined by Council as set out in
Schedule 1 attached to the forming part of this By-Law.
