

HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON

BY-LAW #129/99

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE HAMLET OF FORT MCPHERSON IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS IN THE HAMLET, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE HAMLETS ACT, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.H-1, S.70,(d).

AS IT IS DEEMED to be in the public interest that all buildings within the Municipality have attached to the building an address number;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

- 1. in this by-law;
  - “Council” means the Hamlet Council of Fort McPherson.
  - “Building” means a fixed structure in which people dwell, work, assemble, and play or any other form of use.
  - “Hamlet” means the Municipal Hamlet of Fort McPherson in the Northwest Territories.
  - “Schedule” means a schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law.
  - “SAO” means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2. the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, in consultation with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and Fort McPherson Housing Association, shall assign address numbers
- 3. A list of building numbers shall be maintained at the Hamlet Office for inspection by member of the community.
- 4. The building number plates shall be of a size not less than 10 centimeters in height and placed on the front of the building, so as to be seen clearly from the roadway and only the address number, as assigned by the Hamlet of Fort McPherson, shall appear on the building.
- 5. The placement of the address numbers on the building will be the responsibility of the property owner, with assistance from the Hamlet, if necessary.
- 6. Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$50.00 for the first offence, \$100.00 for the second offence and \$250.00 for the third offence.


